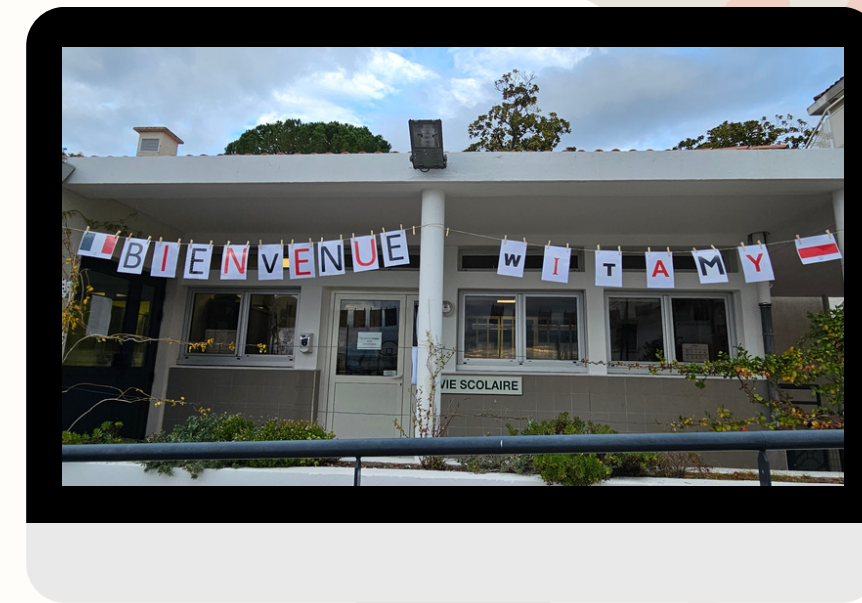

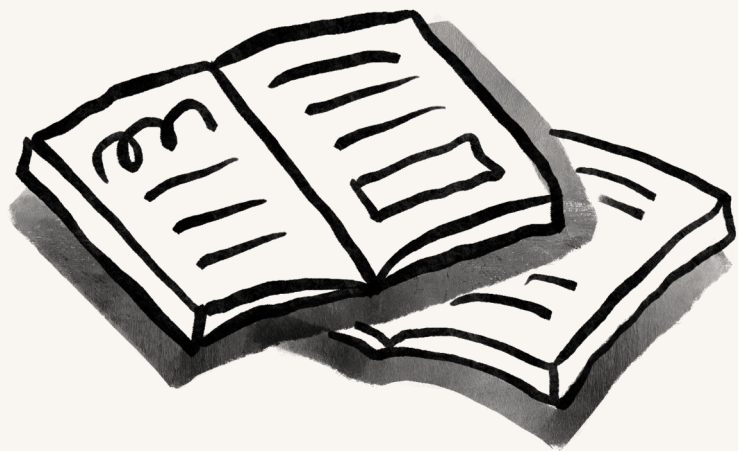
In France, school students have different career paths. After graduating from high school, they can choose between university studies and vocational schools. There are also apprenticeship and internship programs to help gain work experience before entering the job market.





French education systeme

Lycée (High School): Three years of study for students aged 15-18, consisting of the Seconde, Première and Terminale classes. At the end of high school, students take the baccalauréat (high school diploma), which is a key exam at the secondary level. After earning the baccalauréat, students can continue their education at the tertiary level in university, technical or vocational studies. The education system in France aims to provide students with a well-rounded education and allow them to choose the educational path that best suits their interests and skills.



Is it easy for young people to find jobs ?

In a large number of cases in France, an employment contract is possible after the age of 16.

However, there are some restrictions on the type of work, working hours and conditions of employment for those under 18.

In industries such as fast food, fashion or smaller businesses, young people often find summer jobs, especially in smaller factories.



What is the most popular profession in France and why?



Waiter is a popular profession in France . First, the French culture that values good food and drinks has fostered a developed catering industry. Second, tourism plays an important role, with cafes, restaurants and coffee shops being important destinations for tourists and the local community. In addition, working as a waiter often offers flexible hours, which can attract students and those looking for an additional source of income.

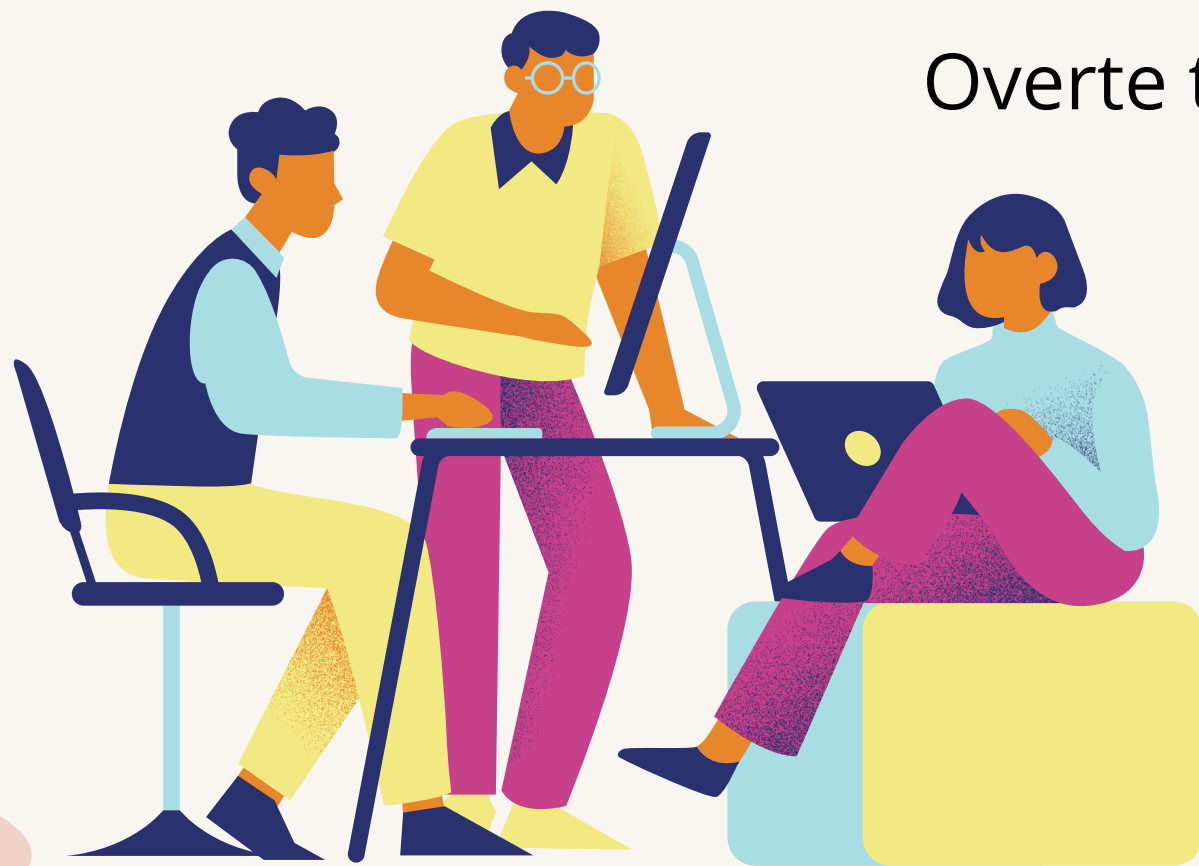

There are many occupational specializations available to students, allowing them to gain practical skills in their chosen fields.

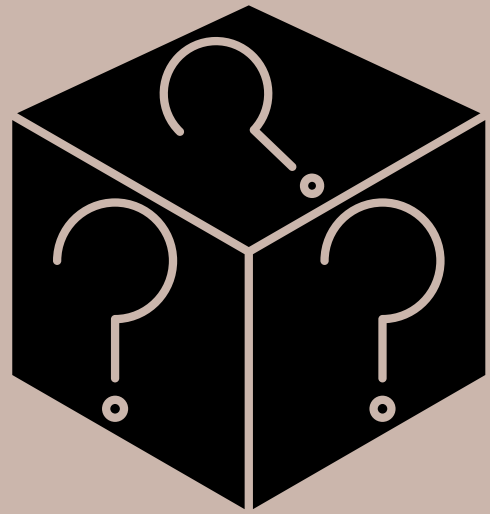
Weaknesses

Creating innovative tourism experiences or solving problems that may arise during travel.

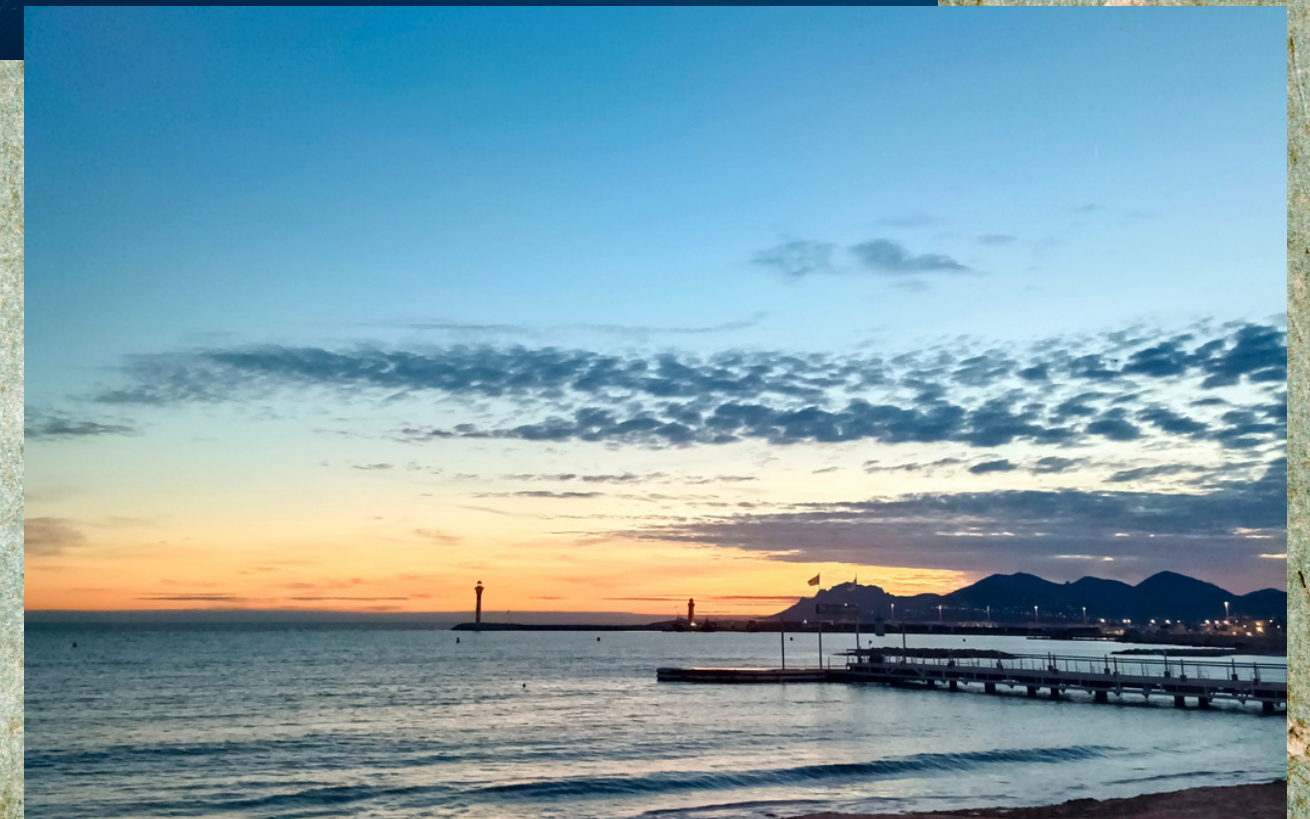
NEGOTIATION

Work safety in the tourism industry

Introduction

- Understanding the essence of work safety in the tourism industry.

- Accident statistics in the tourism sector.

In 2021, 2,947 people died on the roads in France, the number of road accident victims was 9% lower than in 2019, before the start of the Covid-19 pandemic. For the first time in 20 years, the number of cyclists killed on roads exceeded 200.



Work safety is one of the most important issues that should be paid by an employer planning to delegate his employees to France. Both the Polish and French labor codes impose on employers the obligation to protect the life and health of their employees. He should make every effort to provide employees with safe and hygienic working conditions

As in 2020, the number of all road accident victims in metropolitan France was less than the symbolic 3,000, the release noted. In 2019, 3,239 people died on French roads.

Main threats:



- **Transport accidents.**

- **Dangerous weather conditions.**

The weather on the French Riviera is a relatively constant element of everyday life - the sun is usually shining. Despite many sunny days throughout the year, the weather on the Côte d'Azur can be slightly different from place to place. All because of the terrain and the proximity of the sea and mountains.

- **Customer service risks.**

Working with clients is a particular challenge for employees. It is characterized by high emotional demands, exposure to stressful and aggressive behavior from clients and the inability to regenerate individual resources during work. The truck driver died on the spot, crushed by a tree. Traffic has been reopened on national road 31 at the site of the accident, near Ressons-le-Long, in Aisne.

- Staff safety training.

Monitoring and improvement:

- Analysis of accidents and incidents.

On July 30, 2023, a Cessna 177 Cardinal (registration marks F-HKLA) ditched in the sea near the beach at Fréjus on the French Côte d'Azur. There were three people on board the aircraft. All escaped uninjured before the plane sank.



- Continuous improvement of security procedures.

France is a safe country, but petty thefts do occur. They most often occur along the French Riviera and in larger cities. Therefore, always pay attention to your luggage.



- Introducing new standards based on the latest industry trends.



The violent protests that are sweeping through French cities have an impact on tourism. Customers are canceling restaurant visits and hotel reservations. Representatives of the tourism industry expect compensation. Due to these problems, the French Minister of Tourism, Olivia Gregoire, announced the introduction of a strategy to combat overtourism. For now, the government will establish an industry monitoring group to identify the most at-risk sites and define measures to encourage off-season visits.
